Due to the corona measures, all trips, excursions and parent meetings at school are canceled.

## School reopening on June 8

Monday, June 8, we will fully open again for the students. All children will go back to school every day, normal school hours. We are very happy with that!

However, this does not mean everything will be as usual. Distance of 1.5 meters between teacher and children is maintained as much as possible. The guidelines of the PO council also state that parents cannot enter the school and must stay at a distance from school. This also means that a number of planned activities will not take place, such as the parental room, excursions to Artis Zoo, school camp and farewell evening for group 8. The corona virus is simply still among us and therefore meetings or gatherings of more than 30 adults are not possible. A bitter pill for many. But above all, let us cherish and be proud that everything has been going so well so far.

Many hands are washed. Parents leave their child at home when they have a cold and the children quietly enter the school group by group.

All these measures will certainly remain in effect until the summer holidays (and perhaps thereafter). In any case, I would like to give the children and all parents a big compliment! Children take a quiet position in the indicated place on the square (and we will continue to do so). Parents wait on the edge or behind the wide,

red border in the square. Awesome! In this way we take care of each other and we pay attention to each other.

### Important points of attention for parents

On Monday June 8, the school will be fully open to the students again. The measures previously taken still remain in effect:

- Parents are not allowed to enter the school building.
- When waiting, stay behind the wide, red stripe on the square and keep 1.5 meters away from each other.
- Stay at home if you or your child have a cold or flu symptoms.
- Inform the school to call in sick for your child, between 8:00 am and 8:30 am (leave a voicemail).
- Parent conversations take place by telephone or via video calling. An exception may be when the school invites an individual parent to an interview. Even then we keep 1.5 meters apart and the parent is asked to disinfect the hands with hand gel when entering the school. We assume that the parent will take the responsibility to cancel the appointment when there are cold symptoms.

### Closure KDV-BSO Schreuder

This week, many parents were surprised with the message that the BSO-KDV has decided to close after July 3rd. Due to the termination of the lease by AMOS, owner of the school building, they saw no other option. The school team and myself as director very much regret this decision of the childcare. I sincerely hope that all staff will still find a good and pleasant workplace and I want to thank them for the pleasant cooperation that I have experienced over the years.

It is very important for you as a parent what the childcare will look like after 3 July. AMOS indicated in its letter that meetings are taking place and that there will be more clarity about this next week.

### Adjustment of school report cards – June 2020

On Friday, June 26, the school report card will be given to your child (except for group 8). Due to the closure of schools from March 16 to May 10, because of the corona measures, we were unable to give education as we were used to. Distance education was given for 6 weeks: initially a lot of repetition and in-depth material, later also instructions and digital guidance via Meet or Zoom.

In this long period of distance education, we mainly focused on the main subjects: language, reading, (reading comprehension,) spelling and math and less on the subjects of world orientation, creative subjects and physical development. This has consequences for completing this report card.

- An assessment for work attitude has been completed.



- An assessment has been completed for the main subjects (arithmetic, technical reading, reading comprehension, spelling, language) provided that at least 2 method tests have been taken.
- There is no assessment for world orientation, expression and physical education.
- A printout of the LVS results that your son / daughter has made so far is included. (Normally this is only done for groups 6 and 7.)

No KOM interviews are planned for the 2nd report card. If you still consider a conversation with the teacher as a result of the report, you can contact him / her for a telephone appointment.

### After school activities

Now that the school is fully open to the students again, we will continue two after-school activities until the summer holidays. This concerns the remaining drama lessons from Jennefer Siegrist. She has already communicated this to the parents of the students concerned. Movendi will also resume football training on Tuesday afternoon after school. We want to start school chess again after the summer holidays. This also applies to swimming lessons in the Zuiderbad.

### School building renovation

In a previous newsletter I already informed you about the renovation of the school building. All classrooms will be renovated: floors will be replaced, walls painted, wall cabinets moved. Adjustments are also made in the different storage areas and even a new storage room is made, towards the hallway to the gym. The renovation is already in full swing. See the pictures. However, it is not possible to have the entire renovation take place during the summer holidays. Of course we want everything to be ready at the start of the new school year. Fortunately, the team is very cooperative and the workmen (taking RIVM measures into account!) ensure that classrooms are moved and new classrooms are set up.



### Farewell group 8

Throughout the corona crisis, various activities for the students have already been canceled. Unfortunately, group 8 will also miss many farewell activities. Traditionally, a school camp takes place at the end of the school year. We had to cancel this at an earlier stage, due to the limitation in meetings and hygiene measures.



Now the farewell evening, as we are used to with the presence of the parents and other family, will not be able to take place because of the guidelines for primary education. We too find that very sad. Together with the teachers and the class parents, we are working on how we can give the group 8 parents the opportunity to realize the farewell of their child's primary school. The parents of group 8 will be informed about this separately

### “Wenmoment” students on July 2



Only four weeks of school are left and then the summer holidays will start. In the last school week we will “get used to” the new group composition with the teacher for next school year in next year's classroom. What makes it extra exciting is that the students of the Vlinderboom also come to Schreuder to get used to their new classmates, their teacher and the school building. These students have not yet been here in school due to the corona crisis. In addition to getting used to their class, these students will also explore the building (where is the toilet and where can I find the library?) and the immediate surroundings (the afternoon break on Museumplein!).

### Summer camp – English for Bengels – Amsterdam & Amstelveen

The best and most educational summer camp this year in Amsterdam & Amstelveen: Sports, dance, creativity and fun lessons entirely in English. The lessons during Summer Camp are aimed at making the children feel comfortable using the English language. The children are classified by age. The program is adapted to each age group.
